What: We're "Ghana" Read Book Drive

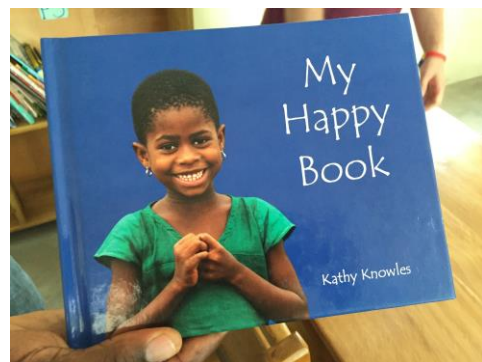
Where: Donations will be collected at Jamison
