While we realize that classroom placement can be a stressful time for students and parents, we ask that you support us in an effort to create well-balanced classrooms. Please be mindful of your conversations in front of your child about this topic. Too much praise about one particular teacher or a negative comment about another can certainly impact how a child reacts to his/her placement.
