Breakfast and Lunch – This is provided by Aramark Education. There are two different options for lunch. Regular meals are \$2.95, premium meals are \$3.40, and market fresh bistro meals are \$3.45. Carton drinks are \$.80. Breakfast is available for \$2.15.

Assignment/Plan Book – You will be given an assignment book on the first day of class. Please use this to record your daily homework and long-term assignments. This also serves as the passbook for leaving class, so it is imperative that you do not lose your books. Replacements are available in the guidance office for \$5.
