Helpful Hints:

- **Absences:** A parent must call the attendance line at 267-893-3420 when their student is absent from school. Please provide a note for the homeroom teacher on the first day back from the absence.
- School Hours: School begins at 7:30 AM and ends at 2:30 PM. All students should be in their seats by 7:30 AM. For supervision and safety reasons, students may not be dropped off at school before 7:10 AM. If a student is not in school by 7:30AM, they will need to report to the main office. Early dismissal is at 10:45 AM.
- Late Arrivals: <u>After the 7:30 AM cutoff</u>, the student must stop by the Main Office with a note from the parent explaining the lateness and to receive a late pass to homeroom. Late arrivals without a note will be documented as Unexcused.
- Appointments during School Day: If a student must leave for an appointment during the school day, they should <u>bring a note</u> to the Main Office before homeroom. The student will be given a pass to leave class at the appropriate time and must sign out in the Main Office.
- **Bus Riders:** All students must ride their assigned bus to and from school. Because of tight seating on buses and the need for bus drivers to keep everyone safe, students may not ride home on a different bus with another student.
- Forgotten lunches and homework: If lunches or other school items are forgotten at home, the parent may drop them off in the Main Office. To avoid interrupting class time, we do not page individual classrooms to have students come to pick up items. Students are told to look for their name on the rolling scroll on the TV to retrieve items left in the Main Office.

Parent Portal:

- The Infinite Campus Parent Portal is a parent-specific login to the shared, community-wide Infinite Campus Student System. The portal provides information about students to authorized parents or guardians in real time. Parents can view their student's schedules, grades, attendance and more.
- All parents will benefit from a parent portal account. If you don't already have an account set up, go to <u>www.cbsd.org</u>. Click on Parent Resources, and then Parent Portal Help.
- **Parent E-Mail Address** E-Mail blasts are sent periodically to parents/guardians regarding upcoming events, important dates and other timely information. Parents can add or change their e-mail address on the parent portal.



Sports Physicals

According to **Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association:**

- 1. A physical exam by the athlete's doctor is required each school year (after June 1). The PIAA Sports Physical form must be completed by both the physician and parent. (The PIAA form is not the same as the physical form required by the school district for new students and all students in grades 6 and 11.)
- 2. The completed PIAA Sports Physical form, Athletic Pledge, Athletic Code of Conduct and Parent Emergency Contact/Consent forms have to be turned in **before trying out** for any sport.
