How does it work? You and your child will both read Michael Northrop's *Tombquest: Book of the Dead*. During our three Monday evening meetings, we will meet together in groups to read together, discuss, and complete projects related to the book. You can order the book through our author visit program (See Gayman Gazette or Library website), or pick up the book at the Doylestown Bookshop or another vendor. All books ordered through the author visit program will be signed by the author and are available at a 20% discount.

What do you need to know?

To make the most of this special experience, it is really important that you do your best to complete the reading schedule below. It requires an average of 15 pages of reading a night for 6 nights a week, with Sundays open as a catch-up day. It is best if you and your child read the book together to allow for discussion as the book unfolds.

Unfortunately, younger siblings cannot attend the event. Older siblings may attend as helpers or in place of a parent (but must read the book). Siblings may share a parent.
