Summer Band Camp & Beginner Lessons are designed to provide opportunities for students to enrich and perform on a band instrument.

Beginning band students will receive two and one-half hours of instruction on their instrument each week. Lessons will be taught in either an individual or small group setting, depending on enrollment. A beginner is a student who has never taken lessons on their instrument.

Experienced band students will receive two 30-minute private lessons and four ensemble rehearsals each week (totaling four private lessons and eight band classes). Lessons will be scheduled either on Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday. Ensemble rehearsal will take place each day from 9:30-11:00 with the lesson schedule built before and after the band class. The camp is open to students entering **grades 5 through 9**.

Parents will be notified of specific lesson times by the Wednesday before the camp begins.

All lessons and ensembles are in the morning and early afternoon.

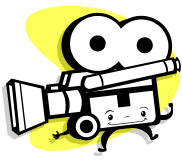
