What is the Lenape Peer Tutoring Program?

~ The mission of the Peer Tutoring Program is to enhance academic achievement. Every effort will be made to match a trained and qualified 1:1 Peer Tutor with a student who requests tutoring in Math, Spanish, or French. Students may also sign up on a limited basis for general homework help (this is not 1:1). The program is open all year on Tuesdays and Thursdays beginning in October from 2:35 - 3:30 p.m. in the library. Students can participate at any point during the year, depending on their need and/or availability. The Peer Tutoring Program will be supervised by Lenape Staff.

How will the Peer Tutoring Program work?

~ Students interested in becoming Peer Tutors at any point during the year must demonstrate qualifications documented on the application, participate in training, and agree to a specific time commitment. Students requesting tutoring must complete a Peer Tutoring Request Form and commit to predetermined sessions. Students may become involved in the program at any point during the year. Peer Tutor training will occur periodically as applications are received.
