One goal of the Central Bucks School District is to revise our current elementary reporting tools. To meet this goal, a committee of classroom teachers, curriculum supervisors, principals, and staff development facilitators have united to develop a *Standards-Based Reporting System* which will take effect in the 2014-2015 school year.
