



Welcome to the AstraZeneca Hope Lodge of the American Cancer Society in the Philadelphia area.

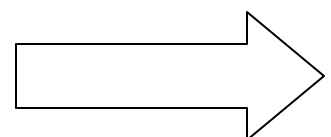
