Ketanji Brown Jackson: An Influential Confirmation

Judge Ketanji Brown Jackson has recently made history, as she has become the first African American woman to be confirmed to the U.S. Supreme Court. The two-time Harvard graduate was awarded the Constance Baker Motley Award from Columbia University's Law School for empowering women of color. In her acceptance speech, she stated that being a judge means "doing the work that is necessary to protect the rule of law and to promote equality and justice for all". Additionally, her and her husband, Patrick, have two daughters, Leila and Talia. Her and Patrick, now a surgeon at MedStar Georgetown University Hospital, met while studying at Harvard. She served as a district judge of the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia from 2013 to 2021, until she was appointed to fill the seat of Attorney General Merrick Garland in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit by President Joe Biden. The fiftyone year old D.C. native will also be the first justice to have experience as a public defender; she was an assistant public defender from 2005-2007. During this time, she says she argued before the Court of Appeals about ten times, and represented several defendants who were not able to afford private counsel. She was then nominated by President Joe Biden on February 28, 2022 to the Supreme Court, and confirmed by the U.S. Senate on April 7, 2022 by a vote of 53-47. Upon her confirmation, she

will replace former Justice Stephen Breyer, whom she clerked for from 1999-2000, which provided her with an inside view of the court processes, as well as Justice Breyer's approach to the role of justice. Furthermore, Judge Jackson would also have more experience than four of the current justices combined.



Judge Jackson is known to have methodical and extremely comprehensive work and rulings. Her opinions and analyzations tend to come from careful investigations of all aspects within a case and a deep respect for one's limits within the law. Her keenness on examining and finding facts to deliver information and arguments can be drawn back to her education, especially at Harvard Law School. Being a black woman in such a predominantly white and male field, it was much harder for her to be listened to and valued. She likely developed her philosophy of assiduousness during this time. Along with this pattern of meticulous work, it should be noted that Jackson is known to adjudicate by law rather than any other forces. While she is democratic and often times liberal, she is known to make decisions solely based on her knowledge within the law. This makes her decisions typically unaltered by external political forces. One example of this unaffected adjudication is in relation to her past as a public defender. This has caused much concern for many people, as they fear that Jackson will be biased and partial in cases concerning criminal defendants. This issue can be easily disputed with an overview of Jackson's past with cases of this sort. On multiple occasions, such as sentence-reducing decisions, the rulings have also been supported/pushed by multiple Republican judges, making it clear that Jackson did not act on a personal or liberal agenda. Overall, it can be gathered that her attention to detail and law-based decisions are crucial for proper adjudication. Due to the revolutionary nature of Jackson's confirmation, it can be expected that many SCOTUS decisions will become even more spotlighted within the media. Despite the controversies that may be created and credited to her confirmation and becoming a justice on the Supreme Court, one thing is for sure: Her nomination is historical, evolutionary, and influential.



Despite the viral conflict between Will Smith and Chris Rock, the Oscars this year had many more highlights. Coming back from the pandemic, 2022 has been a great year in the Academy Awards. All the winners had a lot of art and diversity to celebrate in the films they had worked on.

First, the film, CODA, won the Oscar for Best Picture. This film follows a protagonist who grows up with an entirely deaf family, which sent an impactful message and made it an even more meaningful win. Academy Awards are trying harder to fit in diversity and this film was no exception. In addition, according to Vanity Fair, it was the first streaming film to win an Oscar.

This film, coveted for its characters and music, was an instant success in a wide variety of audiences. Shatter Me: Thoughts from a Re-reader

In Tahereh Mafi's *Shatter Me*, all aspects of the world have gone to chaos. Climate change is at its peak and the majority of the population lives in poverty. With promises of restoring the Earth, The Reestablishment takes over the entire globe, but does not follow through on their garuntees. Juliette Ferrars appears to be a normal seventeen-year-old girl, except for her deadly touch. After being locked in an asylum for 264 days, Juliette is taken to The Reestablishment's base to be used as their weapon. As Juliette rebels against her captor, Warner, the commander of Sector 45, she falls in love with the guard stationed outside of her room, Adam Kent. They conspire a plan to escape to the outside world, but will they be able to run from The Reestablishment?

This book was a great introduction to the *Shatter Me* world. It draws in the reader with its language, twists, and cliff-hangers. Mafi's use of figurative language is unique and engaging throughout the story. Told from the perspective of Juliette, the author's method of crossing out some of the narrator's thoughts vividly shows the main character's insecurities. The use of cross outs throughout the series is a also very distinctive way that Mafi shows character development. Juliette begins to cross things out less and less as she gains confidence in herself and her decisions.
