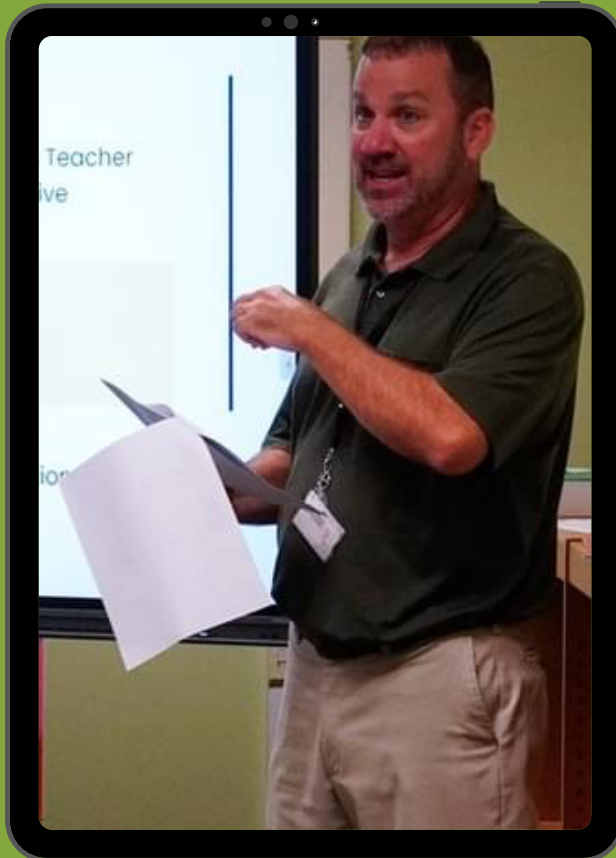


Nicole Smith

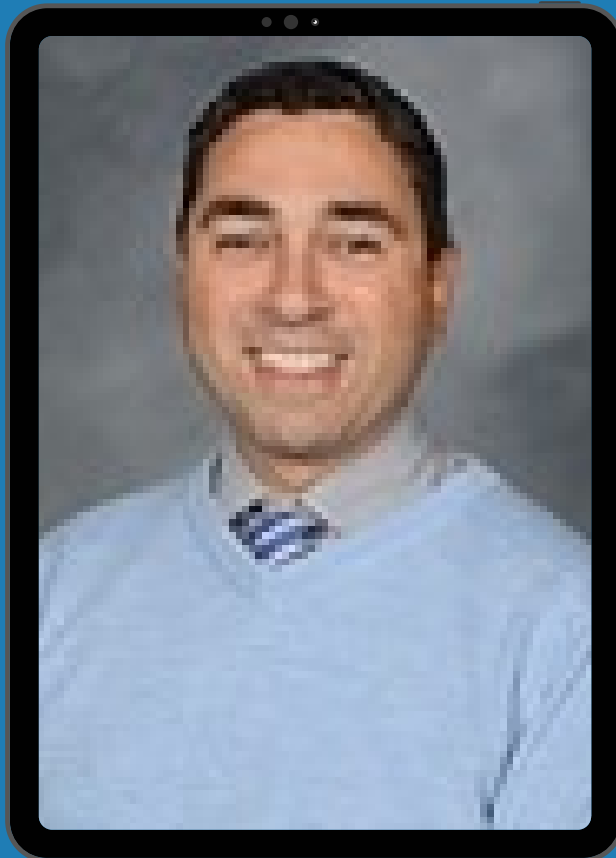


Ed Fell
