Expo Information Sheet

What is the Expo?	The Expo is an opportunity to show off your creativity and innovative skills.
How will the Expo be held?	The Expo will be held virtually this year by students submitting short videos on Flipgrid. There is no official sign up. If you are interested just sign into the Flipgrid and upload your video.
When is the Expo?	Students who are participating have from March 31st until May 10 th to submit their video. The videos will be shared in school on May 13 th , which is Buckingham's Day of Design event.
How long does the video have to be?	There is no set time limit. The max amount of time is 5 minutes.

What should the video show?

The video should show your project working and the student stating the materials used and how it works.

You can live record using Flipgrid or you can select "options" after you hit the 'Record a Response' box and upload a prerecorded clip.

What kind of projects can I do?

Students can create a free build project, build a Lego set, or show off a robot they have at home. Any project or build that has to do with science and engineering can be shared through the Expo.

What kind of projects have been done in the past?

Projects can be big or small.

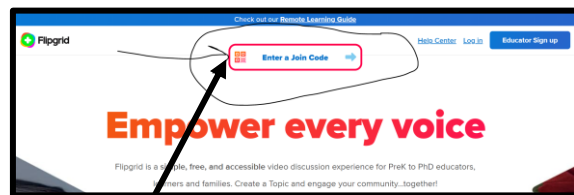

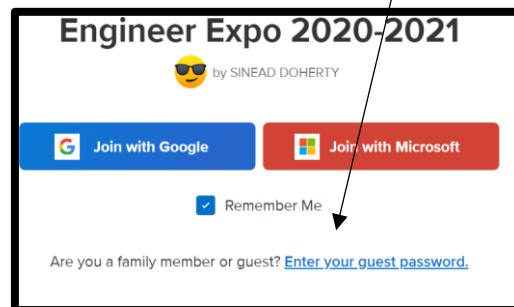
1. Go to flipgrid.com
