COURSE DESCRIPTION


This course is eighteen-week course is a chance for you to challenge yourself, problem solve, and explore your personal story in greater depth.

ABSENT

If you are absent it is your responsibility to speak to the teacher about what you missed. You will not receive extra class time to complete an assignment. ASSIGNMENTS & LATE ASSIGNMENTS 2

Make arrangements to come and work during advisement or one day after school. Arrangements must be made with the teacher at least 1 day prior.

TURNING IN ASSIGNMENTS

Assignments will be turned in during class. Your signature must be in the lower right hand corner of each piece of artwork. **Name. Grade. and Class** should be written on the back of your assignment. Complete self-assessment or reflections when instructed. Students are encouraged to take digital photos of their artwork and complete additional time work when completed early.

UNIT RECOVERY

If you are failing a unit, all assignments from that unit must be completed before unit recovery will be given.

RESTROOM

Request permission and sign out by the door. Keep Hall Pass on you at all times. No one is allowed to leave 10 minutes before the end of class. Only one student may go to the restroom at a time.
