






Also attached, you will find most common word cards you can use to practice at home. Try the following ideas to help your child learn these words:

- 1. Use the words as a resource when completing writing assignments.
- 2. Make a word bank using an index file box or punch a hole in the cards and put on a metal ring.
- 3. Make the words with magnetic letters on the refrigerator or baking sheet.
- 4. Put other words on cards and create sentences with the words.
- 5. Identify sight words when reading with your child.
- 6. Practice writing the words in fun ways, using sidewalk chalk, shaving cream, etc...
