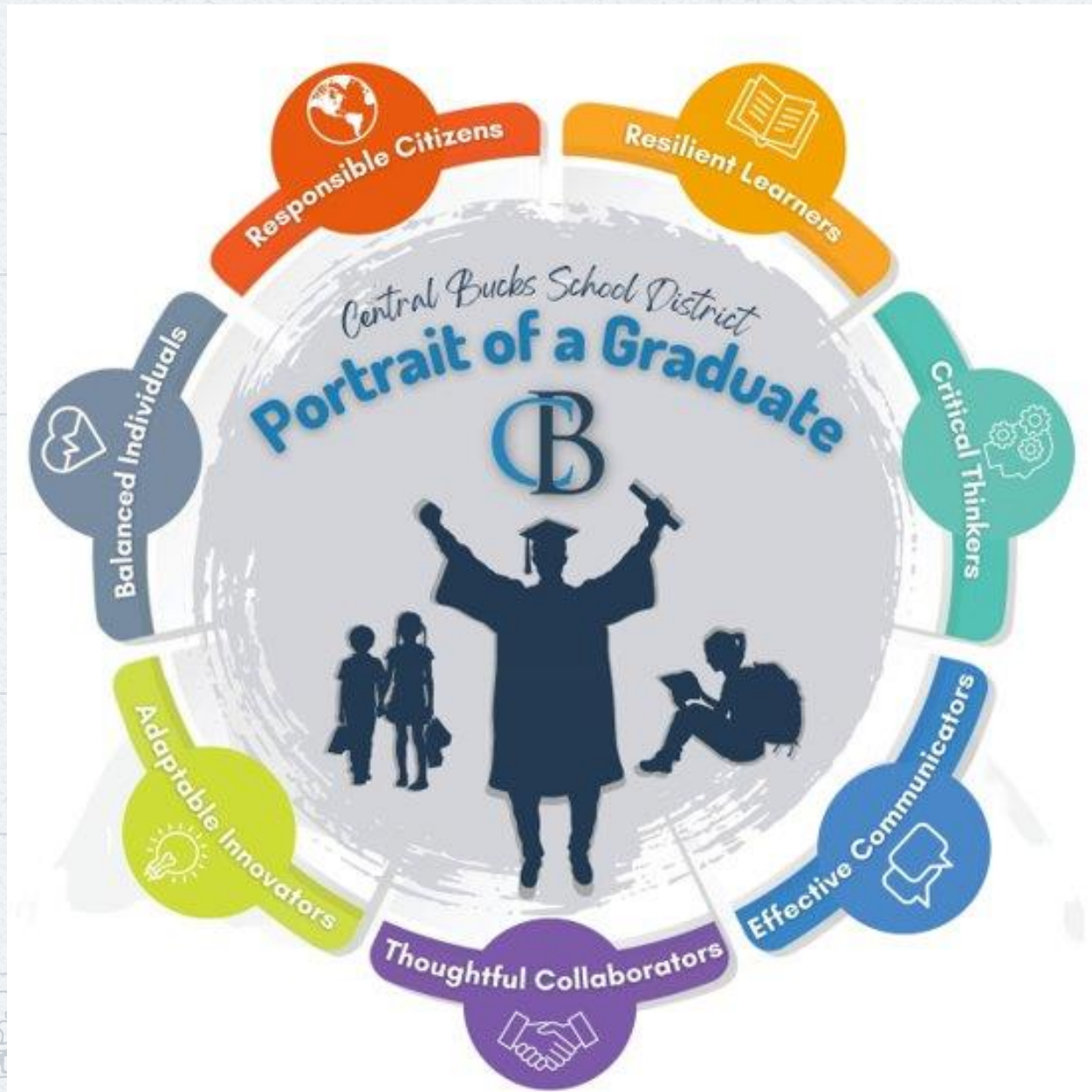
## HVAC UPDATES

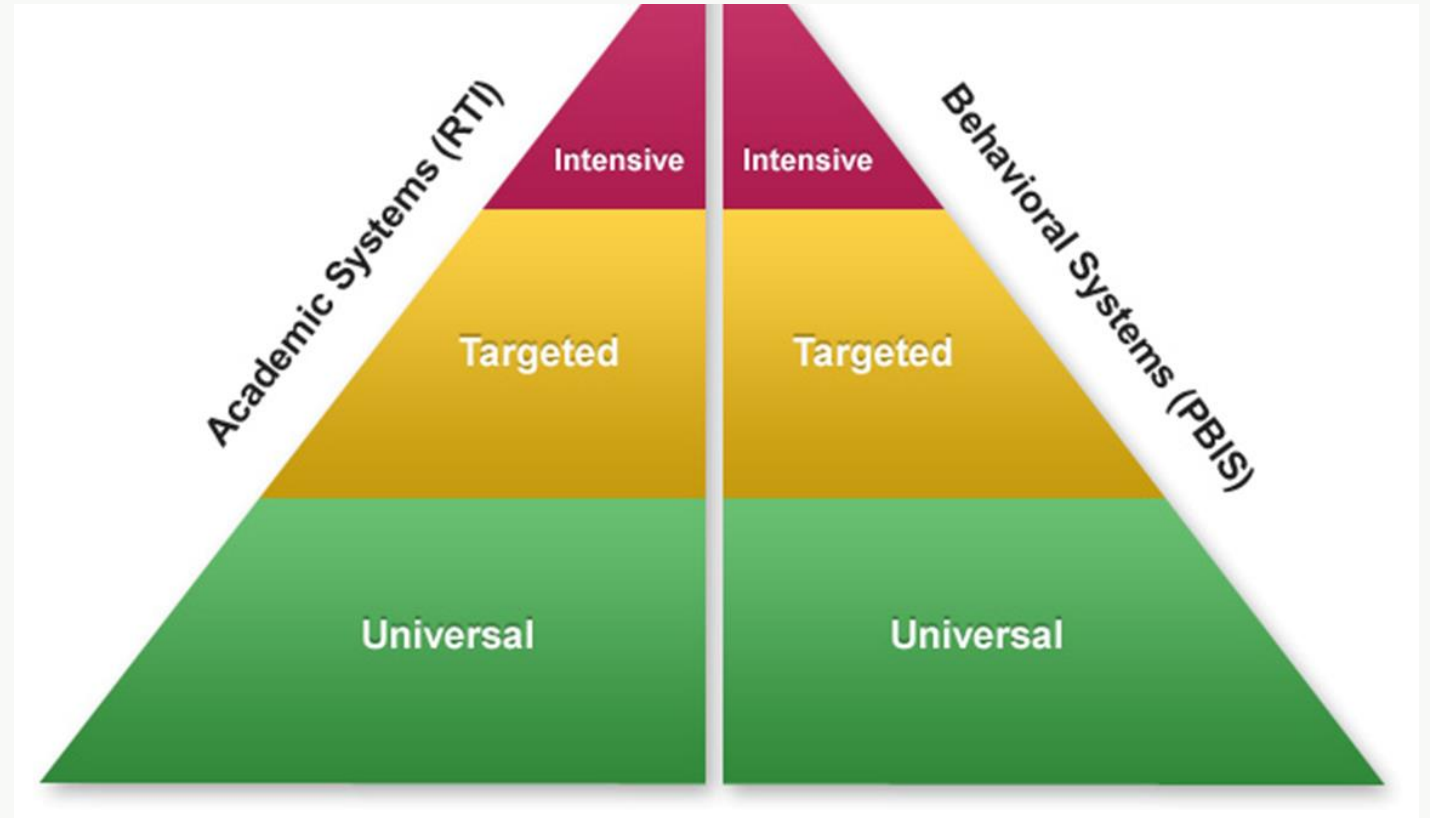

# What is PBIS?



A system of tiered support that explicitly teaches expected behaviors, identifies and collects data on undesired behaviors, and designs supports for students who need it.



# SWPBIS

- x The broad purpose of PBIS is to improve the effectiveness, efficiency, and equity of schools and other agencies. PBIS improves social, emotional, and academic outcomes for all students, including students with disabilities and students from underrepresented groups.

# STUDENT ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Lenape traffic is **ONE WAY** from 7:00 – 7:30 AM and 2:30 – 3:00 PM.

All traffic must enter from **W. STATE STREET (202)** and exit on to **WEST STREET**.

## **BUS RIDERS**

Students will enter the building through the doors next to the **CHOIR ROOM**

## **CAR RIDERS (AM)**

Students arriving **PRIOR to 7:30 AM** will enter through the **GYM DOORS** or **CAFETERIA DOORS**. Use the ROLLER COASTER approach to dropping off to ensure that we have as many cars emptying at one time as possible.

**Please be sure to pull up as far as possible and disembark in the \* DROP OFF /PICK UP ZONE**

Cars then exit onto WEST STREET. **DO NOT U-TURN** through the parking areas. For the students' safety, do not use the church or medical building parking lots for drop off. Please do not drive through the bus lanes that run parallel to West State Street (202).

## **CAR RIDERS (PM)**

Please pull around to the rear of the building as far forward as possible into the\* **DROP OFF/PICK UP ZONE**

Cars then exit onto West Street – **DO NOT U-TURN** through the parking areas Please do not park in the church or medical building parking lots for pick up

**ANY STUDENTS ARRIVING AFTER 7:30 MUST BE BUZZED IN THROUGH THE MAIN OFFICE**

**\*DROP OFF/PICK UP ZONE** is the area between the cafeteria doors and the Gym Entrance



# ELECTRONIC DEVICES
