- Instruction to students in grades 1-6; low student-teacher ratio
- A nine-month commitment, beginning in September
- Foreign language instruction <u>three days per week</u> (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday)
- Classes are <u>one hour per day</u> either before or after school <u>on your elementary campus</u>
- Tuition at \$1,500 per child per year (tuition installments are available); this is only \$15 per class!
- Parent transportation to (morning classes) or from (afternoon classes) required
