What We Have Been Working On

- For **morning work**, over the past two weeks, the class worked with logic problems involving colored manipulatives.
- In **social studies**, the class has continued to lean about Colonial America. We are currently looking at the three colonial regions: New England, Middle, and Southern colonies. Students have been taking notes. We will finish notetaking next week. Then students will have a week to study them, before taking the Chapter 7 test- without notes!
- In **reading**, we have been working in the new, myView reading program. We are finishing up Unit 2. Next, the class will be reading the exciting, fantasy novel, *The Wonderful Wizard of Oz*. (I was never a fan of the movie- but I found the book to be surprisingly engaging. The fourteen book series, written between 1900 and 1920, was the "Harry Potter" of it day.)
- In writing, students just finished writing a personal narrative. We are currently working on a poem using couplets.
- In **math**, my math class will be starting Chapter 5 next week, which deals with computing decimals using all four operations.
