What We Have Been Working On

• For **morning work**, over the past few weeks, the class worked with US state locations, as well as some puzzles involving problem solving.

• In **science**, the class has been learning about a variety of things from our "Nature's Recyclers" unit, such as decomposition, earthworms, carrion beetles, and fungi.

• In **reading**, we have been reading the exciting, fantasy novel, *The Wonderful Wizard of Oz*. The class seems to be enjoying the book. We are up to Chapter 15, out of 24 chapters.
