**Tasks:**

1. 2. Please find a notebook at home to serve as your new notetaking platform. You may also begin to collect notes on a word document that is saved to your one drive. You will think back to your specific Natural Disaster topic and regroup with the general Natural Disaster (ex: Joplin Tornado will now be researching “tornadoes.”)
3. You will access World Book Online (user:cblibrary ; password:cblibrary) and find the WB article on your general topic and begin to read. Approximately 15 minutes.
4. At this point you only need to refresh your memory on your general topic by reading your World Book article.
