

## BLOCK SCHEDULING **IN GRADES** 10-12 THE BENEFITS **TO STUDENTS**

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#### **Organization of the School Day.**

Block schedules are similar to a college course schedule: Most classes are 1 semester.



\* Students can take four courses per marking period \*83 minutes each block



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\* Allows for "doubling up" in a subject area. Students can take multiple Math, Science and World Language classes in one year.

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## **GENERAL INFORMATION**



Most students will take it during 10<sup>th</sup>, so you should plan for this in your schedule.



1 hr each day Access teachers or peer tutors for help You can eat, hang with friends, or use the gym



A/B elective options may not fit with every class. Taking a study hall opposite of a Music/Band/Choir class is a possibility- it is okay!

# **BUILDING YOUR SCHEDULE**

- MAIN SUBJECT CLASSES ARE ENTERED INTO IC BY YOUR CURRENT 9<sup>TH</sup> GRADE TEACHERS BASED ON RECOMMENDATIONS.
- STUDENTS ADD PE/HEALTH, ELECTIVES, AND ANY ADDITIONAL CLASSES.
- THINK ABOUT WHAT YOU WANT TO TAKE DURING 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> so you meet course prerequisites.
- CONSIDER SPORTS, ACTIVITIES, AND OTHER COMMITMENTS. YOU MAY BE RECOMMENDED FOR MULTIPLE HONORS/AP CLASSES. REMEMBER. BALANCE IS KEY!!

**AP CLASSES ARE COLLEGE LEVEL COURSES DESIGNED BY THE COLLEGE BOARD! READING & WRITING EXPECTATIONS WILL BE MUCH HIGHER THAN HONORS.** FOR MOST STUDENTS, THERE WILL BE A PERIOD OF ADJUSTMENT. **TIME & STRESS MANAGEMENT ARE IMPORTANT! IF YOU TYPICALLY DON'T HANDLE** TIME AND STRESS WELL, THIS COULD BE AN ISSUE WITH A RIGOROUS SCHEDULE. **9<sup>TH</sup> GRADE TEACHER RECOMMENDATIONS ARE VALUABLE. YOUR CURRENT TEACHERS KNOW YOU WELL AND WILL MAKE AN INFORMED RECOMMENDATION.**
