



How to Make a Jumbo Paper Snowflake

Materials- For this craft you will need:

- a pair of scissors
- a stapler
- 6 sheets of blank white computer paper
- a roll of tape

How to Make it-

- First, take a sheet of your paper and hold it with the shorter sides on the top and bottom.
- Next, hold the bottom right corner of the paper and fold it over diagonally to make the bottom side line up with the left side.
- You will notice a little bit of extra paper at the top. Take your scissors, and cut that off.
- Hold the paper like an arrow facing left like this. > 
- Fold the bottom half of the arrow up and align it symmetrically with the other half.
- Have the side of this triangle with two folds facing you. Have the paper like an arrow only this time, have it face right like this. > 
- Still have the side with two folds facing you.
- Make three cuts parallel to the longest side. One close to the longest edge, the second one in the middle and the third one near the point. Make sure the cuts are about an inch away from the top.
- Unfold the paper back to full size.
- Take the two inside parts, and bend them to the middle to make a cylinder, and have the tips touch. Either tape or staple them together right at the tips. Repeat this with the other parts alternating sides going from the inside to the outside.
- Repeat all of these directions on your other five sheets of paper.
- When you finish this hold three of them together at the tips and staple them together. Repeat this with the other three.
- Staple these two groups of three together where you did before.
- If needed, staple other parts until it hangs securely.
