Caring for your clarinet



Here are a few simple things that you should do to keep your Clarinet in good working condition throughout the school



- 1. Assemble and disassemble your clarinet <u>carefully</u> as per the instructions. (Never grab it by the keys.)
- 2. Swab out the instrument and disassemble the mouthpiece before putting it in the case. (Make sure it is in the case properly.)
- 3. Wash out the mouthpiece with soap and water once per week.
- 4. **Never** put anything in on top of your clarinet before closing the case.
- 5. Be sure that your case is properly latched before picking it up.
- 6. **Never** leave your Clarinet unattended.
- 7. **Never** let other students play or handle your clarinet.
- 8. Never place your clarinet on a music stand or stand it up on the bell.
- 9. Have an I.D. tag on your case that has your name and school clearly written.
- 10.Practice your minimum 100 minutes per week so the clarinet won't get lonely.
