
## Caring for your Saxophone



Here are a few simple things that you should do to keep your Saxophone in good working condition throughout the school



- 1. Assemble and disassemble your saxophone <u>carefully</u> as per the instructions. (Never grab it by the keys.)
- 2. Swab out the instrument and disassemble the mouthpiece before putting it in the case. (Make sure it is in the case properly.)
- 3. Wash out the mouthpiece with soap and water once per week.
- 4. **Never** put anything in on top of your saxophone before closing the case, <u>especially</u> your folder or lesson book!!!
- 5. Be sure that your case is properly latched before picking it up.
- 6. Never leave your saxophone unattended.
- 7. Never let other students play or handle your saxophone.
- 8. **Never** pick you saxophone up by the neck.
- 9. Don't over tighten the neck screw.
- 10. Have an I.D. tag on your case that has your name and school clearly written.
- 11. Practice your minimum 100 minutes per week so the saxophone won't get lonely.
