Caring for your Trombone



- 1. Assemble you trombone carefully as per the instructions.
- 2. Oil your slide each time you play or practice your trombone.
- 3. Keep the main tuning slide lubricated with petroleum jelly or slide grease.
- 4. Empty the water key before putting your trombone in the case.
- 5. **Never** put anything in on top of your trombone before closing the case, especially your folder or lesson book!!!
- 6. Be sure that your case is properly latched before picking it up.
- 7. Never leave your trombone unattended.
- 8. **Never** let other students play or handle your trombone.
- 9. **Never** hit the mouthpiece into the receptor with your hand.
- 10. Have an I.D. tag on your case that has your name and school clearly written.
- 11.Practice your minimum 100 minutes per week so your trombone won't get lonely.
