Caring for your trumpet



- 1. Oil your valves each time you play or practice your trumpet.
- 2. Press the valves straight down (good hand position) to avoid wear.
- 3. Keep the main tuning slide lubricated with petroleum jelly or slide grease.
- 4. Empty both water keys before putting your trumpet in the case.
- 5. **Never** put anything in on top of your trumpet before closing the case, especially your lesson book!!!
- 6. Be sure that your case is properly latched before picking it up.
- 7. Never leave your trumpet unattended.
- 8. Never let other students play or handle your trumpet.
- 9. Never stand your trumpet up on the bell.
- 10. Never hit the mouthpiece into the receptor with your hand.
- 11. Have an I.D. tag on your case that has your name and school clearly written.
- 12.Practice your minimum 100 minutes per week so your trumpet won't get lonely.
