

Dear Holicong Seventh Grader,

Today is a very exciting day as you will receive your very 1st Holicong Middle School schedule! We are thrilled to have you join our Holicong family and we know that along with the excitement of coming to middle school also comes anticipation....and many questions! We are here to answer all of these questions for both you and your parents!

This is a great time to enter 7th grade and become a Holicong Colonial. The last few years have not been "normal" for sure, but this year we are excited to get back to what we do at Holicong and you will enjoy many former traditions (Spirit Night!) and new ones. You will also be receiving your brand new laptops which we hope will happen on the 1st day of school and will keep you posted on this. And of course you will have new, big lockers to use for the 1st time! Over the coming weeks and first day we will share information through emails, videos and FAQ's to ensure that you and your parents/guardians have everything you need! We have also posted a quick FAQ & dates to know on the back of this letter and these will also be communicated on the first week of school, posted on the calendar (website and school), announcements, and more – yes, we communicate often and in a variety of ways!

Student 1st Day – Monday, August 29th – This is your official 1st day as a Holicong Colonial and we will follow the "A" day schedule listed on your schedule.
