

INTERVENTION & ENRICHMENT



The Goal: Create a clear and specific process and schedule within the school day to provide students an opportunity to receive academic intervention, enrichment, and wellness opportunities based on students' needs that align with the mastery learning and collective efficacy work of the district.

1. Intervention

- a. Mastery Learning for teachers on "what and how" to do intervention with students during this time (not makeup work)
- b. MTSS Model

2. Enrichment

a. Creation and implementation of meaningful enrichment activities for students created by teacher collaboration across district

3. Wellness

a. Creation and implementation of meaningful wellness activities and student service programs created by student support services across district

4. PLC Department Time

- a. Professional development for teachers on creation of PLC's and collaboration within school and across district
- b. Creation of common assessments (formative and summative assessments)
