Health & Safety Updates

With the approval of the CBSD Health & Safety Plan at the August 31 board meeting, we felt it important to consolidate information and provide updates on what this means for students & staff at Holicong Middle School.

Basic 5 W's for the Health & Safety Plan & Masking Order

What is the order: The new health & safety plan requires all students and staff to wear face coverings

inside all buildings and busses in CBSD.

When does it start: Tuesday, September 7, 2021.

Where and when masks <u>ARE</u> required: Masks required in all indoor spaces including busses. Where and when masks <u>ARE</u> NOT required:

- When students are engaged in any activity that cannot be performed while wearing a mask such as eating and drinking or playing an instrument that would be obstructed by the face covering.
- When students are participating in high intensity aerobic or anaerobic activities, including during a physical education class in a well-ventilated location and able to maintain a distance of six feet from all other individuals.
- When a student is participating in a sports practice activity or event, whether indoor or outdoors.

Who is covered b: All students, staff, and visitors, regardless of vaccination status unless approved mask exemption is submitted.

What is process for mask exemptions: Individuals (and parents of students) who wish to request a mask exception must carefully review and submit the Central Bucks School District's face covering exemption form. No other form will be accepted for reason of exemption from the face covering order.

Parents submitting a mask exemption: We have received copies of forms, but we do need an original signed hard copy of the form with a parent/guardian signature. Students can bring this form to Mrs. Loftus or Mrs. Loughlin to the front office on their arrival to school or give it to their 1st period teacher.

<u>Holicong Policies & Protocols</u> – We do not have many adjustments to make due to the updated health & safety plan. We have noted the "adjustments and no adjustments" in the chart below and will reviewing best practices with students tomorrow during our Intervention & Enrichment period - 9.8.21 Health & Safety Updates and Polices Procedures,
