## <u>Student 1<sup>st</sup> Day – Tuesday, September 5 (A DAY)</u> – Below is a brief overview of your first day.

- If you get to school before 7:20, you will report to the cafeteria. If you come in after 7:20 you will report directly to 1<sup>st</sup> period where you will get a new hardcopy of your schedule.
- The cafeteria will be your home base for the year if you arrive before 7:20 and will be supervised by Mr. McVey, Mrs. Passerini, and Mr. Simon.

- You will have 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> period and then we will have our opening assembly for the year with the entire 9<sup>th</sup> grade. We will welcome you as a class and review all of the information you need to know.
- After the assembly you will go to I & E and follow your schedule. You will get follow-up about specific information during I & E and resource this year all students will have resource on A days.

The freshman year looks a bit different that 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade and this year in terms of the team assignment.
