From the Coffee House Crew

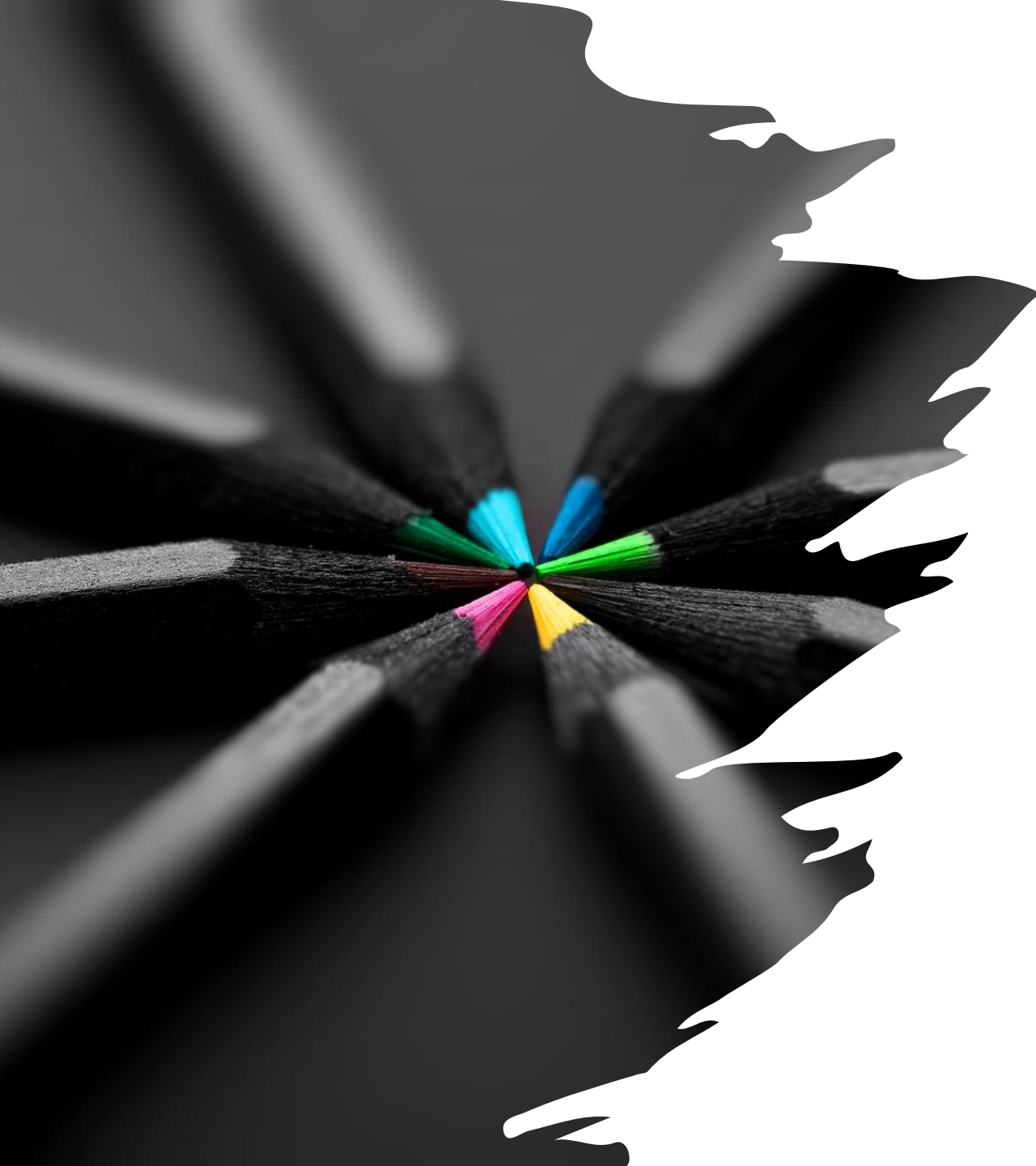
- This year's event will be held on the bus loading platform. Please bring a chair or blanket for comfortable seating.
