- ✓ Faculty Meeting For our whole group faculty meeting we worked on school goals, ALICE drill feedback, and other school business.
- ✓ Patriot Day & Robert Kibbe We remembered the victims 9/11 on Wednesday by taking a moment of silence and conducting a special Advisory lesson created by Mrs. Keyes. This allowed students to learn about this day and what it meant to our country. Mrs. Keyes also reminded students & staff about our Robert Kibbe, one of our Holicong teachers who is currently deployed overseas. Students have the opportunity over the next week to write thank you's to him and others serving our country and we organized a way for all of us to contribute to send a care package to the troops on behalf of the Holicong community please see here how you can help.
