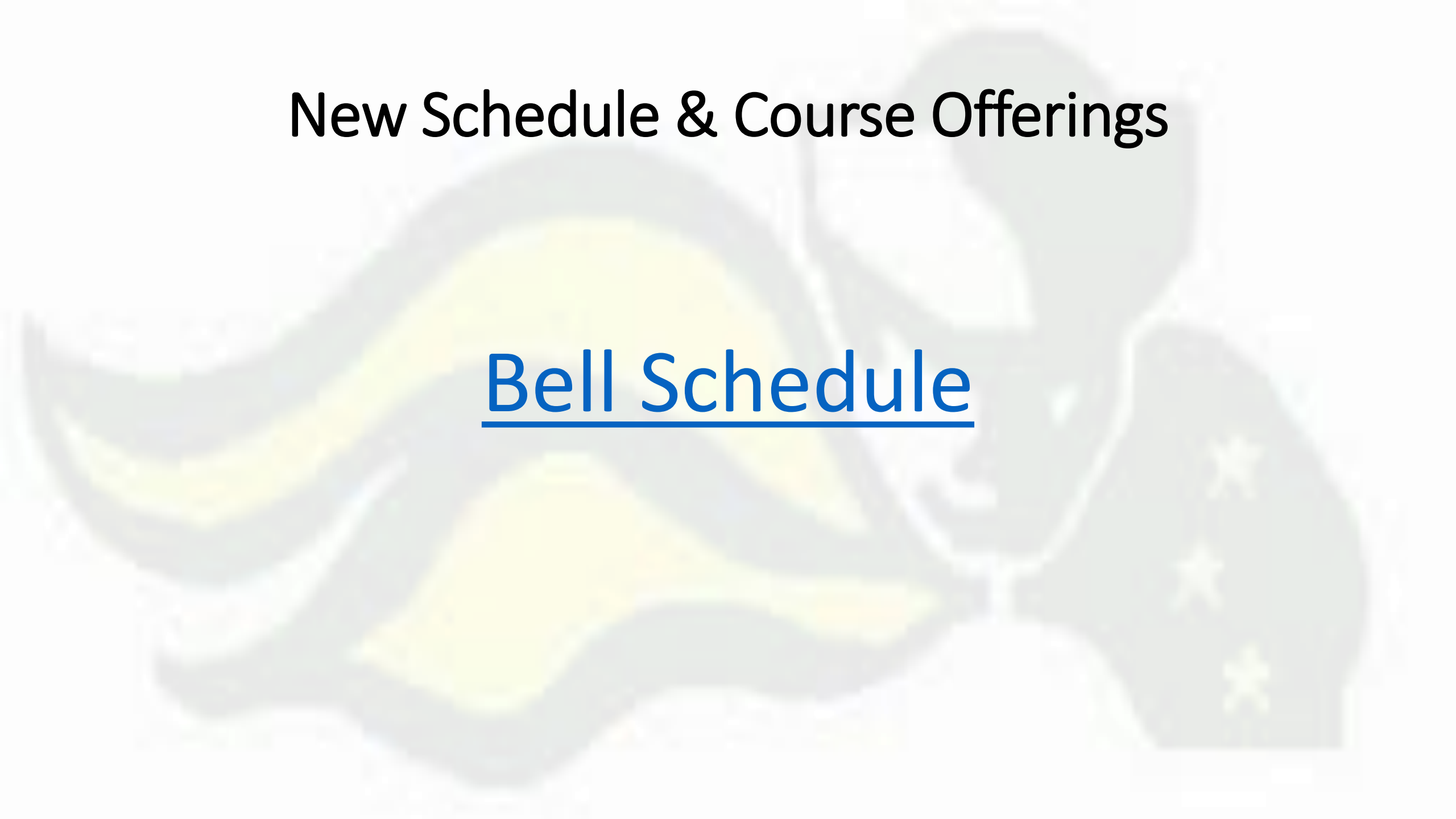

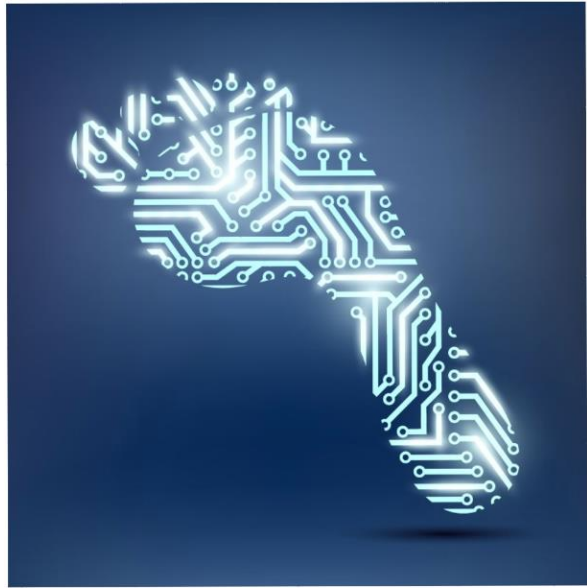



# COURSE DESCRIPTION

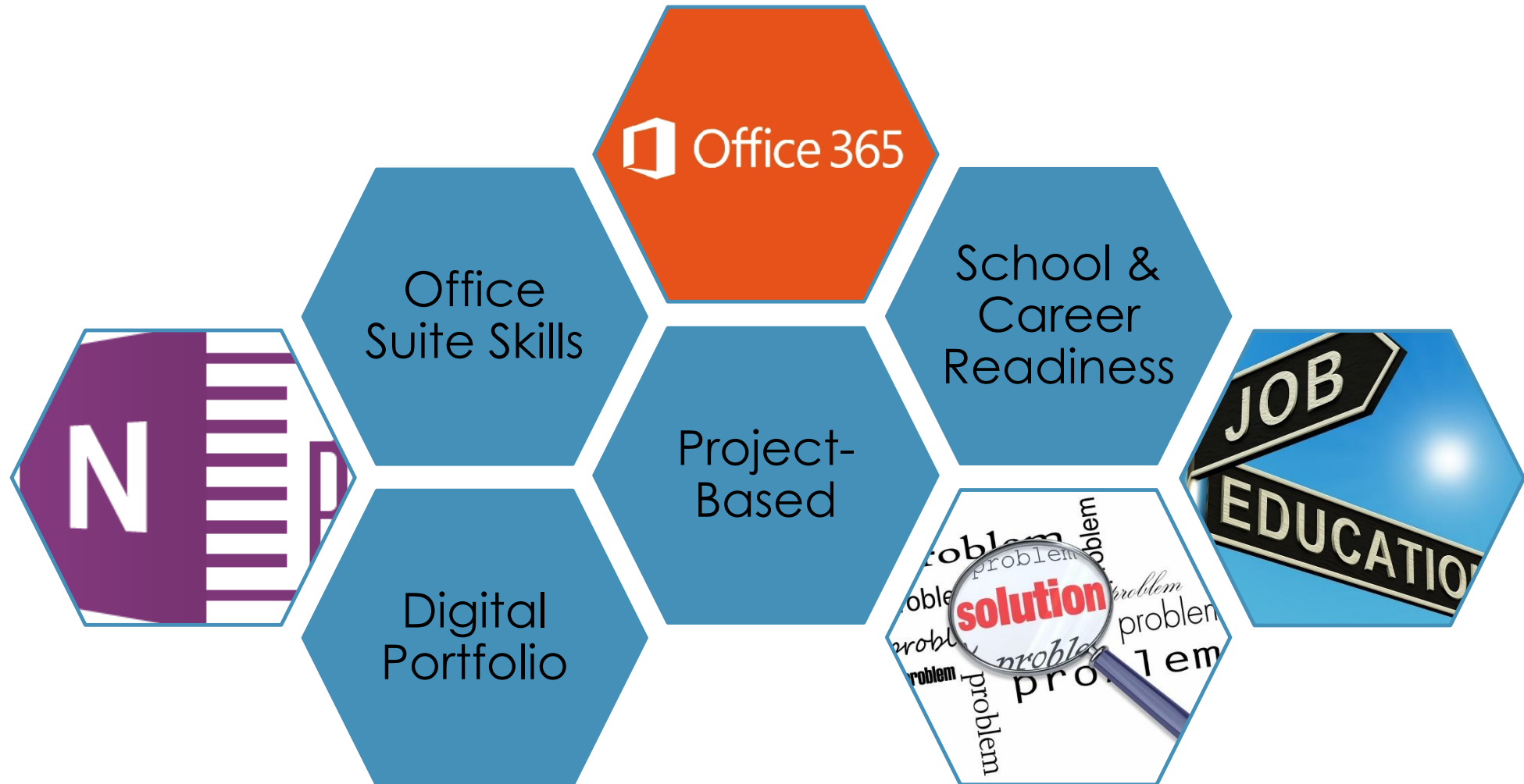
In this course, students' technological skill sets will be expanded and a sense of **digital citizenship** enhanced through a **project-based approach** that utilizes **Central Bucks Technology Standards** and builds upon the elementary **technology toolkit**.

Hands-on, problem-based activities focused on 21<sup>st</sup> century skills and career readiness.



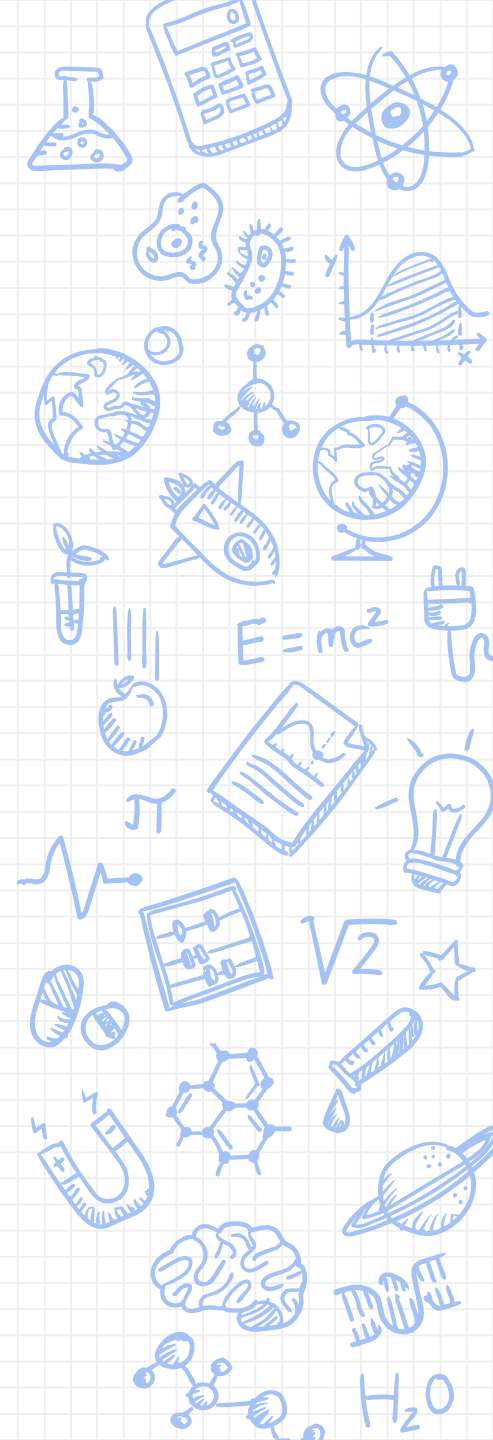
Exposure to a variety of career pathways, including Health Services and Business Information Systems.

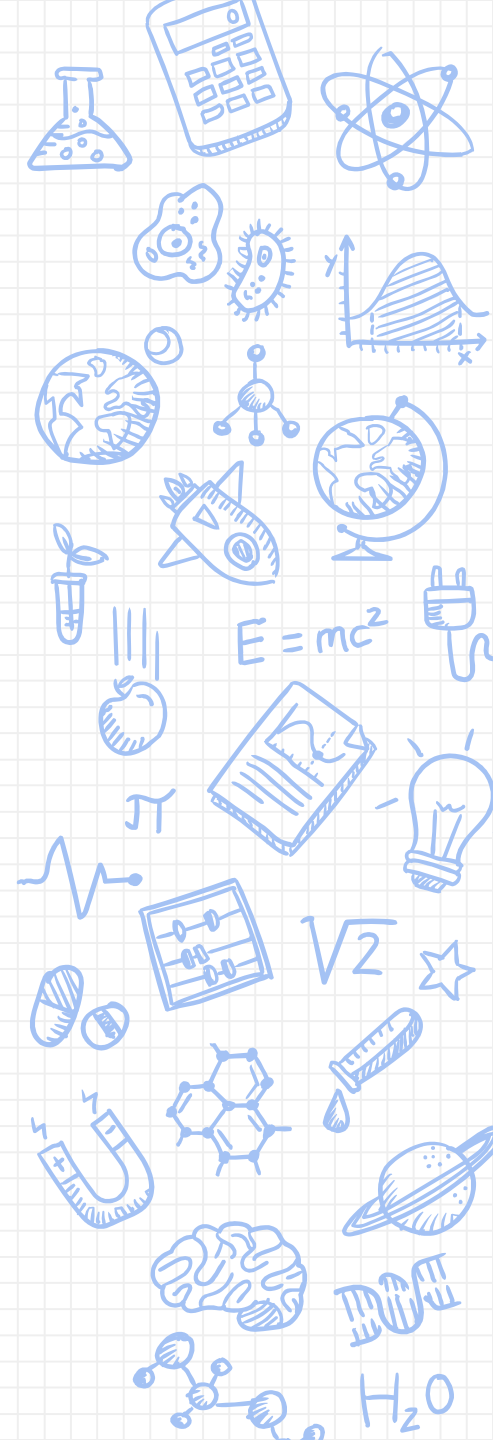
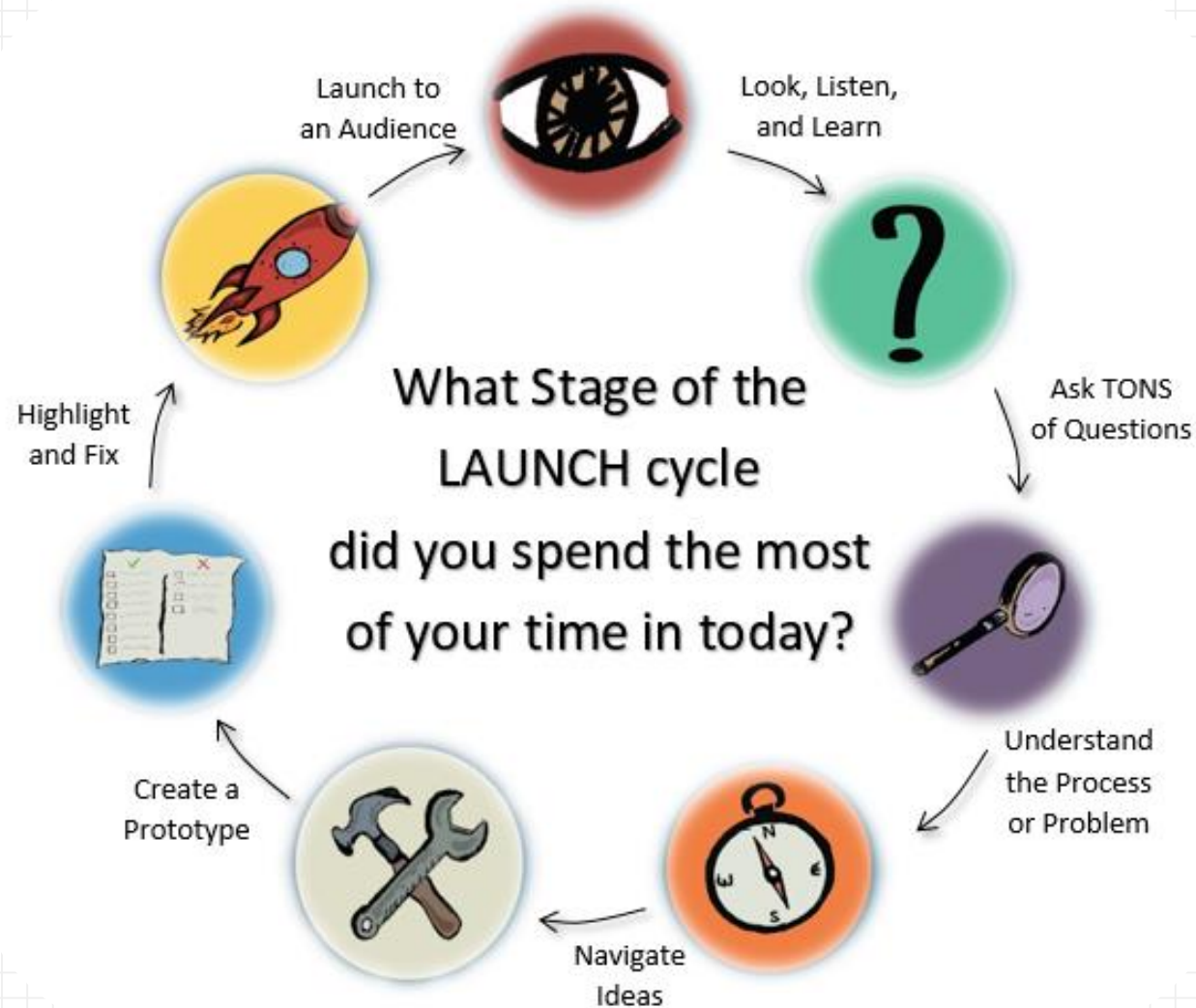

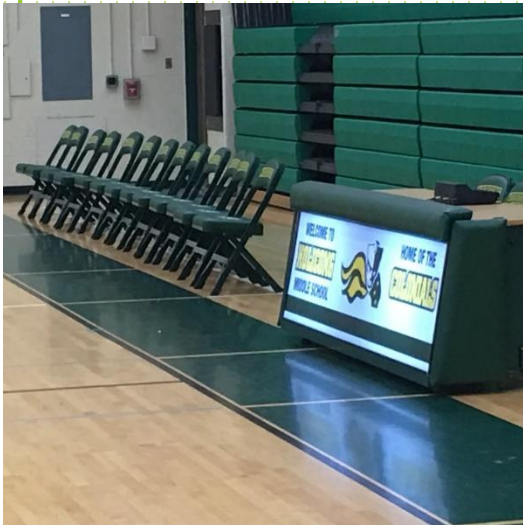
