Who? Mr. Knoedler, Nicole Mascio and Jess Hamalian will be hosting a fundraiser for The Gift of Life Foundation


What? The Holicong male staff will be growing beards until February 16th. On this date, they will be shaving their beards into one of three designs which will be voted by the students


Where? Outside of Holicong's cafeteria
