- Curriculum Updates Dr. Davidheiser
  - Naviance available for rising 9<sup>th</sup> graders for next year
  - Recommendation for Adoption 2 new classes for next year
    - General Social Studies Grades 10-12 "aimed at providing ELs with an opportunity to learn these concepts that will be important in their postsecondary lives"
    - AP Studio Art Grades 11-12 not based on a written exam; instead, students submit a portfolio for evaluation at the end of year: Drawing or 2-D Design (Breadth, Concentration, Quality)
- Project Updates Mr. Kleimenhagen
  - 14 of 23 district schools having work done over the summer
  - o CB East pool chiller replacement to help with humidifier/dehumidifier
  - Holicong MS paving front and back
  - All schools wiring is completed for kiosks, on delivery for end of week; 11 of 23 wiring done for buzzers/cameras outside of school
- Dual Enrollment Dr. Kopicki
  - 10th-12<sup>th</sup> grades Junior and Senior courses all AP and most Honors courses articulation agreement with colleges
  - Lackawanna, MCCC and hopefully BCCC small fee, credits given (transcript provided)
    for classes which can be applied to state schools, including but not exclusive to: PS, Pitt,
    Temple, UScranton, Kutztown, Bloomsburg, Lehigh, etc
  - o All AP courses can get credit whether you take the test or not
  - Possible to walk into college with > 41 credits
  - Will begin starting September 18
  - Grandfathering of classes already taken is undetermined at this time, but will be revisited
