

Dear Holicong Freshman,

You have been waiting for this day since the day you first stepped in to your 1st day of kindergarten (you just don't remember!) but on Tuesday you will be in 9th grade and officially a high school student! **Congratulations!** It is an exciting time for you and also for our faculty & staff as you are now the leaders of Holicong and will set the example for our 7th & 8th grade students on what we do and how we do it. This means modeling the Colonial Cores and always showing kindness and respect for others at all times. Our culture and focus on community is what make Holicong such a special place and we will look to you to carry on this tradition. <u>Freshmen Team Overview</u> – 9th grade is set up a bit different than 7th & 8th grade. You will work essentially as one team as classes are not grouped, but you will see your resource class is either 9A or 9C. We have divided the class in this manner for a variety of team building activities throughout the year. The Freshmen team leaders who will be are Mr. Kaeser, Mr. McVey, and Mrs. Smith.

Student 1st Day – Tuesday, September 3rd (A DAY) – Below is a brief overview of the first day of school.

- **Start of day** You will report to the cafeteria when you report to school. This will be your "home base" (similar to the main gym last year) from 7:05 7:20. You will start the day in 1st period where you will get a new copy of your schedule and teachers will review your schedule for the day and your individual schedules.
- "A Day" We will follow this schedule for the day so you will have your resource and specials class.
- I & E Some of your I & E teacher may have changed since you picked up your schedule and this is on purpose to allow your I & E to be on the same 9A/9C as your resource.
- Other Handouts You will get your student handbook (each student gets one) and this will also act as your passbook/hall pass so please hold on to this! You will also get your Aramark lunch code to use at lunches for the year. You will need this for the year as well.
- Class Assembly After 2nd period we will have our opening assembly for the year with the entire 9th grade. We will welcome you as a class and provide an overview of those primary procedures that you need to know about. A reminder about the primary policies below:

- End of Day We will dismiss a few minutes early so you will have time to get to your locker and your bus or parent pickup.

AM Procedures: Doors open for student arrival at 7:05. Bus riders that exit the bus at East will walk up the crosswalk and be directed by staff to the bus platform doors. You will walk back the crosswalk at the end of the day to get back on your bus for PM departure. If you arrive before 7:20 you will report to the **cafeteria** and stay there until 7:20 and then go to your locker and report to 1st period by 7:30. If you arrive after 7:20, you can report directly to your locker.
