



## Reading Bingo Board

After you read your book to someone, complete one of the activities. Cross out the activity that you did. How many BINGOs can you get in one week? Or you could play "Four Corners" Bingo and complete each activity in the corners of the board. Or you could play "Full Board" and complete ALL of the activities on this board. Have fun!

<p><u>Ask the Author or Illustrator</u></p> <p>Do you have a question for the author or illustrator? What are you wondering about? Write the title of your book and any questions you have for the author, illustrator, or for both.</p>	<p><u>Punctuation Detective</u></p> <p>Find all the punctuation marks. Make a tally mark for each one you see. Which mark is the leader? Which mark has the least? Find these: <u>Period</u>, <u>Comma</u>, <u>Exclamation Point!</u> <u>Question mark?</u></p>	<p><u>Making Friends</u></p> <p>Tell someone about what it might be like to have the main character as a friend. Describe what you might do together and what you might have in common.</p>
<p><u>YOUR CHOICE</u></p> <p>You decide! You can choose to do one of your favorite activity from the other boxes and do it again for this space. Or, you can create your own writing activity for the book you read. It's YOUR CHOICE 😊</p>	<p><u>Performance Time</u></p> <p>Choose a part of the book to act out. Your audience can be a friend, parent, family or your stuffed animals. You can choose to ask others join you to be the different characters in your book. You can also perform the whole story!</p>	<p><u>Character Description</u></p> <p>Draw a picture of your favorite character. Write adjectives (describing words) around your drawing that describe why he or she is special. Some words you might use: kind, helpful, funny, creative, friendly</p>
<p><u>Journal Entry</u></p> <p>Pretend you are one of the characters. Write about what happened and how the things that happened made you feel. Remember, you are writing as if you were the character.</p>	<p><u>Be the Illustrator</u></p> <p>Illustrate your favorite part of the story or book. Label your picture.</p>	<p><u>Be the Author</u></p> <p>You've decided that the story shouldn't end. Write what would happen next. Be sure to use the same characters, but everything else is up to you!</p>
