Welcome to First Grade at Mill Creek Elementary



The First Grade Team would like to welcome you and your child to Mill Creek Elementary! We are very excited about the opportunity to work with you to make this upcoming school year a success. Below is a list of supplies for the year. Please note that crayons, a binder and pencils are not listed, as these will be provided by the school.

Supplies needed for the first day of school:

- A small supply box (no larger than a cigar box)
- 2 folders (regular two-pocket folder, any type is fine)
- 1 mesh pencil pouch with 3-hole punches (This will be clipped into a binder.)
