- Pumpkins may be dropped off at the office from 8:40-2:30.
- From 3:45-4:00—bring to the back doors of the library (Door # 19)
- 3. Pick-Up Procedures (October 31st)
 - Weather permitting, all pumpkins will be on display along the sidewalk between the library doors and the 3rd grade wing. You are welcome to pick up your child's pumpkin after the parade.
 - Remaining pumpkins will be delivered to classrooms whenever possible. Large pumpkins that are left over will be placed outside the library door (Door 19) to pick up after school.
 - Any leftover pumpkins will be disposed of on November 1.

- Select a pumpkin your student can carry!
- o DO NOT CARVE real pumpkins (they rot on us!). Decorate with paint (acrylic is best—poster paint flakes off), stickers, paper, etc.
- o Coating your pumpkin with ModPodge will help preserve any paint you use.
- o Students, friends, and families are welcome to work as a team.
- o Remember that ALL students use our library—Keep it friendly for our kindergarteners!
