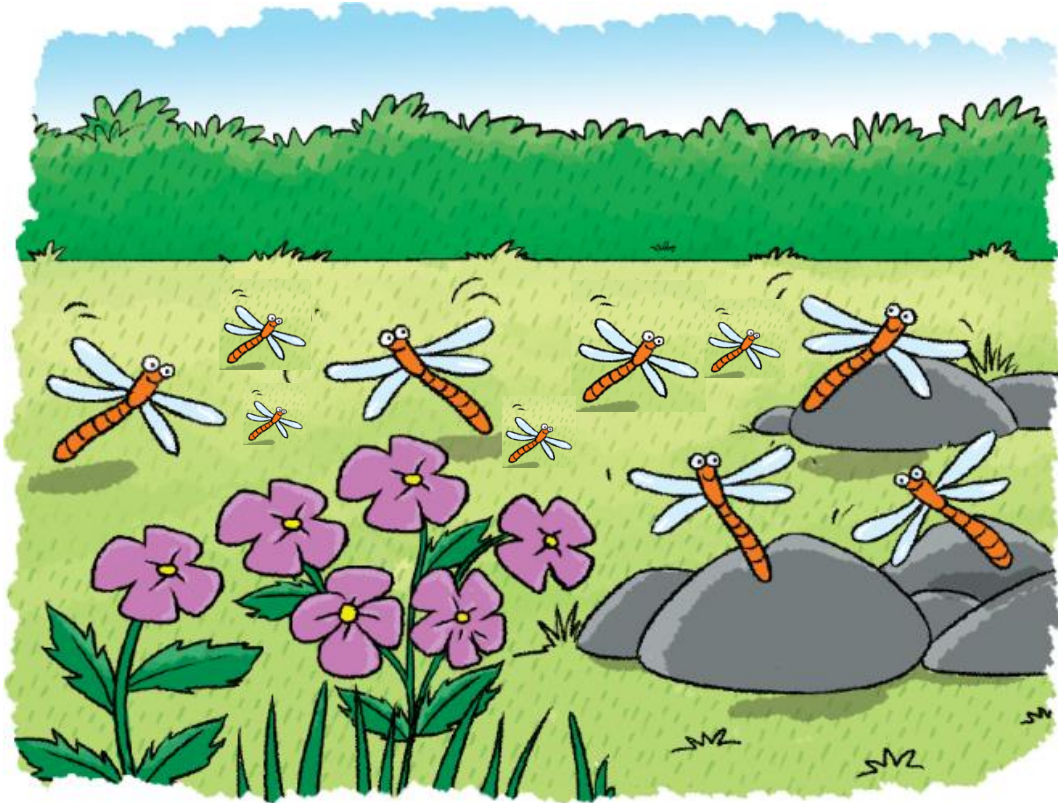


Grade 1, Day 3 Math: Addition and Subtraction Practice

Directions: Using the given picture, what can you see in the picture? Tell an addition story about it. Write your addition story.

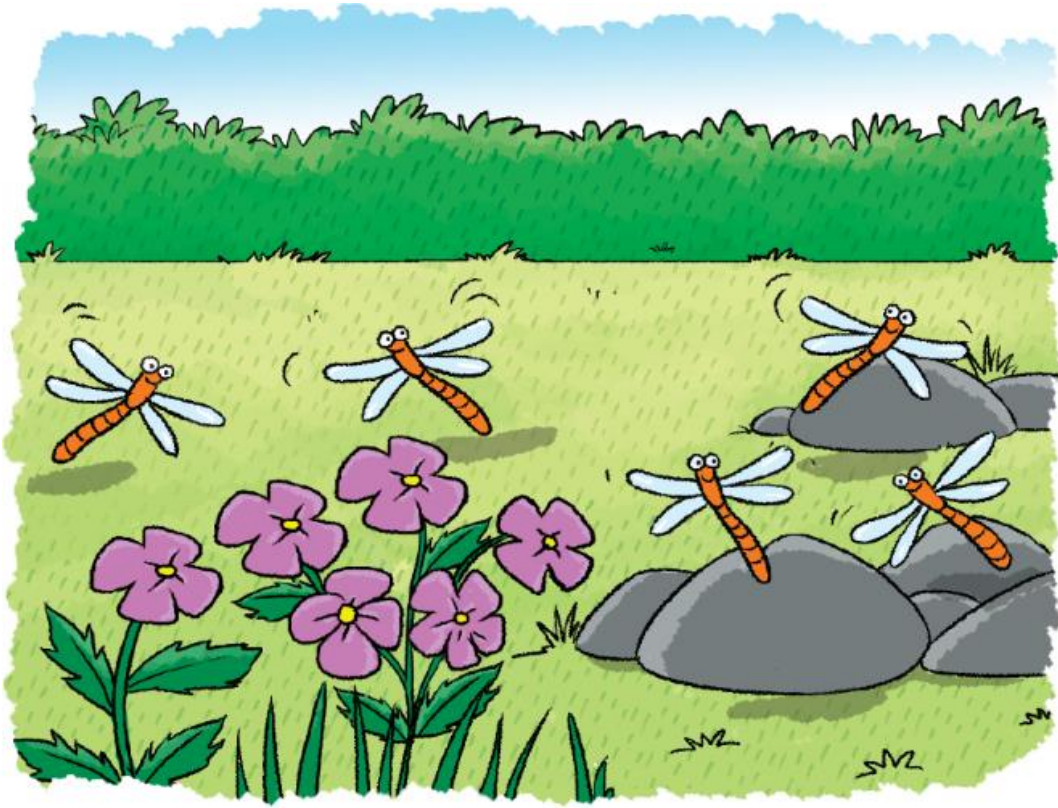
Example: "I see 3 purple flowers. I see 3 more purple flowers. There are 6 purple flowers in all. $3+3=6$ purple flowers."

Directions: Using the given picture, what can you see in the picture? Tell a subtraction story about it. Write your subtraction story.

Example: "I see 6 purple flowers. I picked two purple flowers (I would cross off the purple flowers to show I picked them). There is 4 purple flowers left. $6-4=2$ flowers left."

Directions: Make and draw your own addition story. Tell an addition story about it to someone at home. Write an addition sentence to match.

Example: *"I have 8 pink plates. I have 8 blue plates. How many plates do I have in all?"*

Directions: Make and draw your own subtraction story. Tell a subtraction story about it to someone at home. Write a subtraction sentence to match.
