

Kindergarten: Reading and Language Arts

2 Day Lesson

Tuesday, April 14 and Wednesday, April 15, 2020

Overview:

This is a 2-day lesson for Tuesday and Wednesday. We will celebrate Poetry Month in Kindergarten! We will explore reading poetry, listening to poetry, and writing our own poetry over the next two weeks. Today, listen to the poem, "Little Bo Peep." Then read the poem "Little Bo Peep." You already have it printed out in your Distance Learning envelope. Complete the Family Reading Activity Page that goes with the poem. Practice reading and writing the 40 Kindergarten High frequency Words. Focus on the words with dots in the boxes. Pick a favorite book and read it outside. You can also use Bookflix username: bookflix45 Password: pink . Read over the Talking Points below and have an adult ask you the comprehension questions.

Things to know:

1. Sit with mom, dad, grandparent or guardian, or your brother or sister to complete the activities for today.
2. Take out the Poem and Family Activity page titled "Little Bo Peep" from your Distance Learning envelope.
3. If you do not have the supplied Poem and Family Activity Worksheet it is fine to create your own based off the supplied attachments.
4. April is National Poetry Month, and today's lesson for reading and writing will focus on Poetry to celebrate rhyming words.
5. We will also practice our 40 High Frequency Words and read a fiction book outside
6. Time: 30 minutes on Tuesday, 40 minutes on Wednesday

1.Lesson Introduction: Poem and rhyming words introduction. Read Little Bo Peep poem and complete the Family Activity Page.	Phonics: Read the “Little Bo Peep” poem found in your Distance Learning Envelope family in the poem. Act out the verb/ action word “wagging” in the poem and have two unknown words and learn to read these new words. Complete the Family C and return to it in a little.
