Overview: non-fiction books, Non-fiction books are based facts, real events or real people. Today we are going

to read a book about butterflies.

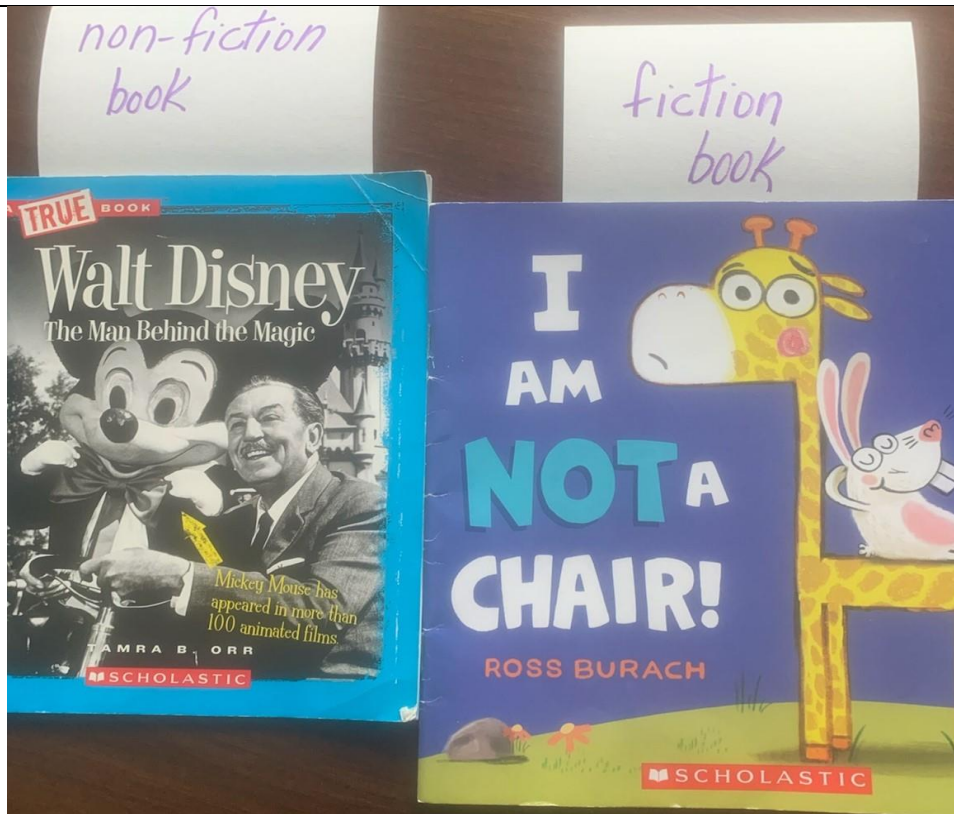
Things to know:

1. Now sit with mom, dad, grandparent or guardian, or your brother or sister to practice the activities for the day.
2. If you do not have the supplied worksheets or access to any of the worksheets, it is fine to create your own based off the supplied worksheets.
3. This week's lesson for reading and writing, will be on a non-fiction book. The book will be about butterflies.
4. We will focus on specific sight words, listen/read a story and then have a response.

<p>paper and practice sight words.</p>	<p>Practice writing your sight words on the paper provided (on web-site, or any piece of paper, you could use chalk, shaving cream or be creative).</p> <p>Now challenge yourself, can you make up 1 sentence for each word, you can just tell someone in your house your sentence, you do not need to write it out. Be sure it is a complete sentence.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can you find the focus sight words <i>have</i> and <i>for</i> within the butterfly story?

<p>3. Do:</p>	<p>Nonfiction books are about real facts. We have listened/read a story about the weather and now butterflies. These stories are true. Fiction books are made up from someone’s imagination, they are make-believe or not real.</p> <p>Now- look for a fiction book in your house. Do you have one? How about a non-fiction book? Do you have a book in your house that tells you real facts about a topic? If you do not have a fiction or non-fiction book in your house, it is ok. If you do...</p> <p>Please put both of your books together and take one picture of a fiction book in your house and a non-fiction book. You can label the books, like I did, if you want. Here is my example:</p>



Please send your teacher the picture of both a fiction and non-fiction book. Now, you know the difference between these two kinds of books.

<p>4. Writing: Complete non-fiction chalk drawing.</p>	<p>Do you have sidewalk chalk? Is it nice outside? If you do not, you can “air write” these words. Practice writing the words: fiction and non-fiction. You do not need to submit this writing assignment for this lesson.</p>
