Kindergarten Day 1 Writing

Overview: Listen to the story, Freight Train, by Donald Crews, read on You Tube (follow the link on my web-site). Answer the comprehension questions that go along with the story.

Estimated Time: Approximately 30-40 minutes

Explanation: You will listen to the story, Freight Train. You will engage in answering comprehension questions and brainstorm some ideas about the story.

Things to know:

- 1. Sit with mom, dad, grandparent or guardian, or your brother or sister to "turn and talk" or "pair share" what the story was about.
- 2. Some questions to discuss can include: Have you ever been on a train? If so, where did you go? If you have never been on a train, do you want to ride on one? And if so, where would you want to go?
- 3. Donald Crews, the author likes trains. They interest him. Talk to an adult about what interests you?

Tasks:

- 1. Listen to the story read.
- 2. Brainstorm with an adult about something that interests you. Just like trains interest the author, Donald Crews.
- 3. Ask the adult you are sitting with what interests them as well.
- 4. Re-listen to the story to prepare for the writing piece in tomorrow's lessons.

** Enrichment and follow up activities- practicing writing the Kindergarten 40 sight words. Get a regular piece of paper, draw a picture of what you see outside your window. Remember to use detail in your picture. After drawing, please label the picture using Kidwriting.**
