

Kindergarten, Day 1 Math

Overview: Counting and Writing Numbers to 5.

Estimated Time: Approximately 30-40 minutes

Explanation: You will count out loud to 5 forward and backward, count pictures and write numbers to 5.

Things to know:

1. Sit with mom, dad, grandparent or guardian, or your brother or sister to practice counting and writing numbers 1-5.
2. If you are unable to print the worksheets to go along with this activity. Use household items for your child to count like beans, noodles, stuffed animals, etc.
3. If you do not have the supplied worksheets or access to any of the worksheets, it is fine to create your own based off the supplied worksheets.
4. More specific directions are provided on each sheet/activity that goes along with these lessons. I will send these sheets through email.

Tasks:

1. Count to 5 forward and backward.
2. You will count the given pictures and write each number.
3. Trace numbers 1 to 5 and color a picture to match each number amount.
