Social Studies


Overview: Our Social Studies unit this month is all about Farms and Farm Animals. We will continue to explore farms this week within our social studies lessons. We will take a closer look at dairy farms. What is a Dairy Farm? What does it produce for us? What kind of animals live on a Dairy Farm?

Lesson Introduction: Brainstorm some ideas.	How does food from a farm get to your table at home? Do you know? Brainstorm some ideas out loud with a parent, sibling, or stuffed friend. Today we are going to learn about a specific type of farm, a dairy farm. Do you know what dairy is? Do you like to drink milk? Do you like to eat yogurt? How about ice cream? Yum!
1. Learn: Introduce to a specific farm, a dairy farm.	Listen or read this story about a dairy farm. You will need to put in the username and password to access the book. <p>2. Try: You are a Dairy Farmer today!</p>	<p>Tell an adult, sibling or stuffed friend 2 things you would do if you were a dairy farmer? What do you need on your farm?</p>
<p>3. Do: Pair/Share</p>	<p>Now, which room in your house would have dairy products? Would it be your bedroom? In your back yard? It would be in your... kitchen! With an adult, ask a parent to help you and find a product in your refrigerator or freezer that is dairy. Remember what you learned from the book, what kinds of foods are dairy? Now, find one or more dairy products in your house, that you like or maybe you don't like and have mom or dad take a picture, you can be in it too! Please submit that picture to me. See my example to help.</p> 
<p>4. Extra Practice: Draw a picture. Write a sentence.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you would like, draw a picture of a dairy farm and label it. • What other kinds of dairy do you have in your house or kitchen?
