The Senses of Touch and Smell

Overview: This month in Science we will be studying the human body. For today's lesson, we are going to review our 5 Senses and focus on the senses of **touch and smell**.

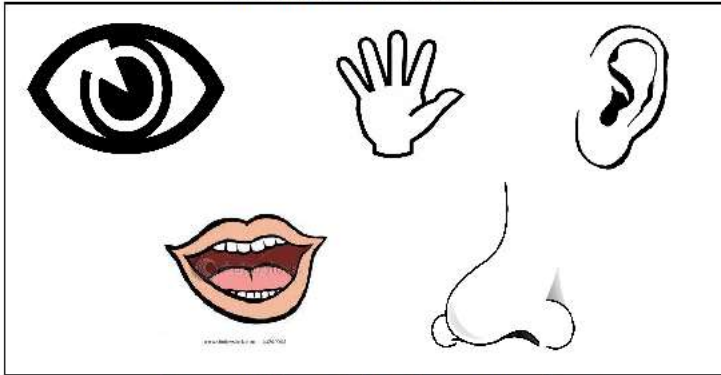
