Thursday, March 19, 2020 Kindergarten Day 4 Writing Free Choice

Overview: Student will have "free choice" for a writing activity

Estimated Time: Approximately 30-40 minutes

Explanation: You will think of a topic that you feel strongly about. Tell your opinion and reasons why you feel that way.

Things to know:

- 1. Sit with mom, dad, grandparent or guardian, or your brother or sister to "turn and talk" or "pair share" what you love, what do you feel strongly about?
- 2. Brainstorm ideas of what you love. Is it a toy? Is it an activity you like to do? Is it a favorite food?
- 3. Take out your writer's notebook from your DL envelope and turn to page 3.

Tasks:

- 1. Generate ideas for your writing topic. Talk with a family member about what you love? Do you like to dance? Do you love to play/watch sports? Do you love reading books? It is your choice.
- 2. Take out your writer's notebook and turn to page 3, entitled "free choice". Sketch/draw your ideas.
- 3. When ready, begin to write about your picture. Just like we do in school. How can you start your sentence? Will it be an "I" sentence? I like...
- 4. Please look at the Writing a 5 Star Sentence paper to help you remember:
 - a. Did I use an uppercase letter at the beginning of the sentence?
 - b. Did I space in between my words?
 - c. Does my sentence make sense?
 - d. Do I have punctuation at the end of my sentence?
- 5. After writing, share your story with a family member.

How is this assignment turned in to the teacher: Since this writing occurred in your writer's notebook, you will just put it in your DL envelope and bring back to me when we return to Warwick.

** Enrichment and follow up activities- practicing writing the Kindergarten 40 sight words. Get a regular piece of paper, draw a picture of what you see outside your window. Remember to use detail in your picture. After drawing, please label the picture using Kid Writing**
