Social Studies

Overview: Our Social Studies unit this month is The Farm and Farm Animals. We will continue to explore

farms this week within our social studies lessons.

This week we are learning and “visiting” a Dairy Farm.

Things to Know:

1. Sit with mom, dad, grandparent, stuffed friend or guardian, or your older brother or sister to enjoy the activities.
2. We are going on a field trip today, a virtual field trip. That means we are going to visit a farm on the computer.
3. Grab a cup of milk (if you like it and are allowed), sit back and relax while we learn how milk is made.
4. Have Fun!

Explanation: We will go on a virtual trip to a dairy farm in the state of Michigan.

Tasks	Resources
Lesson Introduction: Think about it...	Think about what we learned from Tuesday. There are several workers on a farm that make the farm function (work). Think about what job you would like to have on a farm. Would you like to feed the animals? Would you like to collect the eggs? How about milk the cows? Today we are

	going to go on a virtual field trip to a farm, a dairy farm. A dairy farm is a farm that produces milk or milk products.
1. Learn: Watch this video about a Dairy farm in Michigan.	Here is a link to a Dairy Farm in Michigan. It is a little long at 31 minutes, so you do not have to watch the entire video. It shows how a farm works and what the jobs people have to help milk the cows. Do you like to drink milk? Well, if you do, this is the first step to putting it in the containers, bringing it to the store and then on your table to drink. 3. Do: Share	Share out loud with a parent, sibling or stuffed friend... 2 things that you learned from our field trip to the farm. Example: #1 I learned that there are so many cows on one dairy farm. #2 I learned that this farm milks their cows day and night!
4. Extra Practice: Draw a picture. Write a sentence.	1-You could draw a picture of your favorite (if you have one) milk product. Do you like milk? Chocolate milk? Do you like ice cream? How about cheese or yogurt? Draw a picture and label it.
5. How is this assignment turned into the teacher?	There are no written activities for this lesson. So, you do not have to send your teacher any written work unless you completed the extra practice, which is completely optional.
