## 1. World Book Kids (access via Holicong Library Databases)

→ When you visit World Book, choose “Kids” for basic research articles



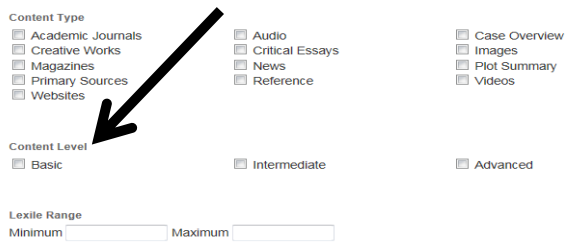
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## 2. Student Resources (access via Holicong Library Databases)

→ When searching, click “Advanced Search”



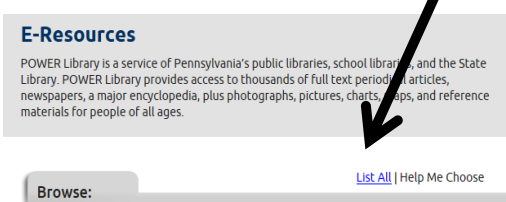
→ Choose the level of article based on readability



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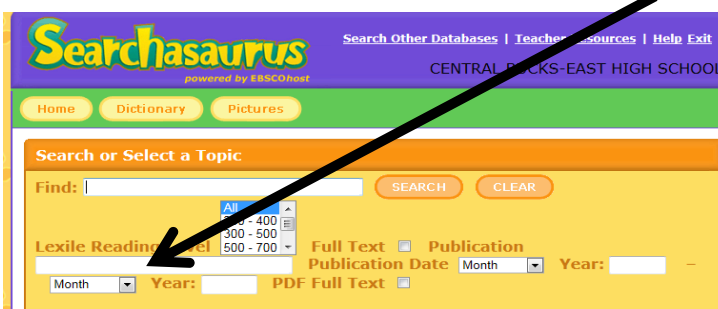
## 3. Access PA: Searchasaurus (access via Holicong Library Databases...then click on Access PA)

→ After clicking on Access PA...click “List All”



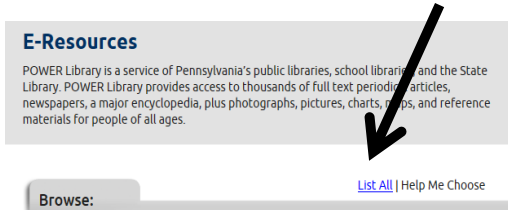
→ Scroll down and click on “Searchasaurus”

→ Students can do a basic search and/or search by Lexile Level



#### 4. Access PA: Kids Search (access via Holicong Library Databases...then click on Access PA)

→ After clicking on Access PA...click “List All”

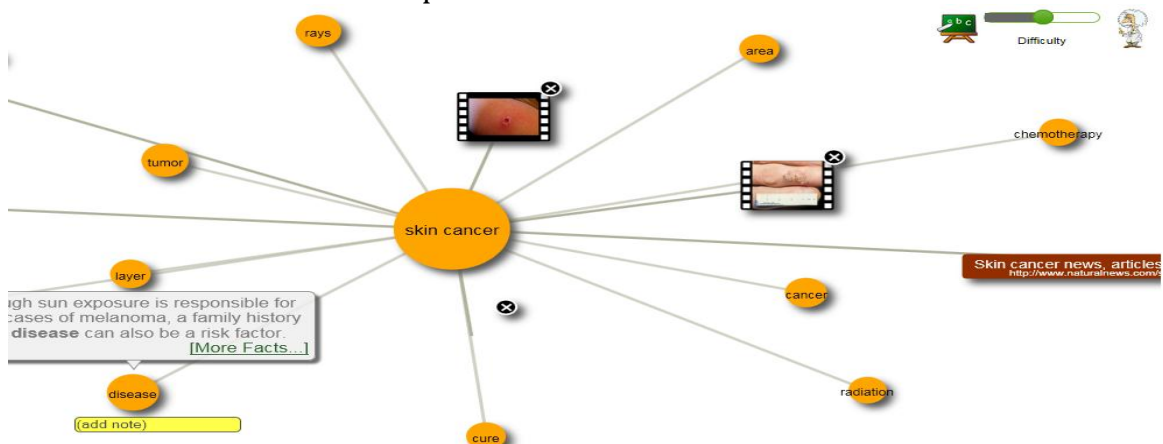


→ Choose “Kids Search”

→ This tool provides students with a web diagram for their results. Meaning, if they don't know much about their topics this search will provide them with subtopics related to their main topic in the form of a web. Great visual and a place to start.
