
World War II

Outcome: The Pacific Theater



1. Setting the Stage: Aggression in Asia

- a. 1931: Japan invaded Manchuria (NE province of China rich in minerals)
- b. 1937: Japan invaded **China** who was experiencing a **civil war**
- c. Japan needed <u>raw materials</u> especially <u>oil</u> to be #1 in Asia



2. Attack at Pearl Harbor


- a. Japan had hoped to cripple the **U.S. Pacific fleet**
- b. Several carriers were out to sea when Japan attacked on Dec. 7, '49
- c. Japan also attacked <u>Guam</u>, <u>Wake</u> Island, Midway Islands, and the Philippine Islands on the same day
- d. Once the home front <u>mobilization</u> hit high production, Japan truly did awaken a <u>sleeping giant</u>

3. Doolittle Raid

- a. <u>James Doolittle</u> led a raid on Tokyo with <u>B-25</u> bombers
- b. Helped boost American Morale
- c. Showed the Japanese were not <u>invincible</u>
- d. Inflicted <u>little damage</u> to the city

4. Island Hopping

- a. The **Supreme Allied Commander** for the Pacific Theater was Gen. <u>Douglas MacArthur</u>
- b. The U.S. adopted the Island Hopping or <u>Leap Frog</u> strategy moving from island to island
- c. The Fighting in the Pacific was <u>difficult</u> for several reasons:
 - i. 100 degree heat ---> humidity caused jungle rot & diseases
 - ii. Many <u>islands</u>
 - iii. Japanese motto "Death before dishonor"
 - iv. <u>Kamikaze</u> attacks: suicide attacks damaged 300 ships and caused 15,000 casualties



5. Key Victories for the Allies

- a. Battle of Midway
 - Japanese hoped to use Midway as a base to <u>neutralize Pearl Harbor</u>
 - ii. Balance of power in the Pacific shifted towards the Allies






b. Battle of **Guadalcanal**

- i. The Japanese advance was **stopped**
- ii. All **momentum** shifted to the **U.S.**



The Battle of Guadalcanal as seen in...






c. Battle of **Iwo Jima**

- i. 20,500 Japanese killed and 6,000 U.S. lives lost
- ii. Put Americans within striking distance of Japanese home islands
