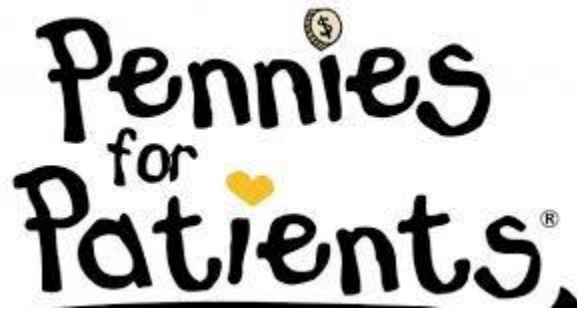


Jamison Elementary School
